of These Things MOVE ME! JESSE DUPLANTIS

The apostle Paul was a powerful preacher who traveled preaching the Gospel. Before Paul left Ephesus to go to Jerusalem, he wanted to be transparent and share his heart with the elders. In his farewell message to the leaders at Ephesus, Paul said some things that I want to share with you this month—I think they're profound and can change the way you live your life. His words sure have changed my life!

And when they were come to him, he said unto them, Ye know, from the first day that I came into Asia, after what manner I have been with you at all seasons,

Serving the LORD with all humility of mind, and with many tears, and temptations, which befell me by the lying in wait of the Jews:

Acts 20:18-19

In other words, Paul was saying that he'd been with them through thick and thin. He'd been serving God with them and it hadn't always been easy. Paul wanted these men to know that he had to keep his mind humble through it all—meaning He had endeavored to focus on God's ways instead of his own ways. He wanted them to know that he'd shed many tears during this time and dealt with lots of temptation.

Paul also made sure to let them know that his mental struggles, tears, and temptations didn't come at the hand of God—they came at the hand of the Jews who were plotting against him. No, not the Romans. Not the heathens. It was those religious people who were trying to do him in! Sound familiar?

I can relate to Paul's problems with the religious crowd. In my ministry, I've had very few problems with the lost. They're more open and, sometimes, more kind. But I've had more than my fair share of problems with Christians. They backbite and criticize. They stir up all sorts of strife. They aren't just thorns in my flesh; they're complete bushes! How many times have I said to God, "It's those religious people. God, wipe 'em out! They're messing up my witness and making it hard for me." But God doesn't listen to that. He loves everybody—even those Christians who irritate the socks off of me!

But Paul reminds his leaders that he never held anything back from them, even through the hard times.

And how I kept back nothing that was profitable unto you, but have shewed you, and have taught you publicly, and from house to house,

Testifying both to the Jews, and also to the Greeks, repentance toward God, and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ.

Acts 20:20-21

Paul led these elders by example, teaching publicly by going house to house witnessing for Christ. He was open and transparent with them. And as he travels back to Jerusalem, you can tell that Paul is feeling uncertain about what's going to happen to him. He says, "And now, behold, I go bound in the spirit unto Jerusalem, not knowing the things that shall befall me there" (vs. 22).

Notice that Paul doesn't know everything just because he is the apostle Paul. He's just going because he's under a commission from God. But, even though he's uncertain about the future, there's one thing Paul is sure of: "Save that the Holy Ghost witnesseth in every city, saying that bonds and afflictions abide me" (vs. 23).

Paul knew that he couldn't see results on his own. He knew the value and power of the Holy Spirit—that when he talked to somebody about Jesus, it wasn't his eloquent words that would make them consider salvation. Paul knew it was the pull of the Holy Spirit on their heart. He recognized that the Holy Spirit was witnessing with him through all that awaited him in Jerusalem—even tears, temptations, bonds, and afflictions.

Now, you'd think Paul would give up, right? I mean, it was tough for him to keep traveling and witnessing for Christ when the religious people were so bent on giving him a hard time. But Paul does no such thing. Instead, he sets his face like flint and says to the elders:

But none of these things move me, ither count I my life dear unto myself, s

neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and

the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the Gospel of the grace of God.

Acts 20:24

Paul wouldn't give up.

Wipe Your Eyes and Choose Joy

Life's tough, but unless you want to fall down and die over your troubles, it's time for you to get up, straighten up your mind, wipe your tears away, resist the temptation to quit and say, "None of these things move me! I will finish my course with joy."

I've had many opportunities to give up in my life and my ministry, I just didn't take any. Some people think that's arrogant. It's not. It's called confidence. I've got confidence in my God—He is more than able to finish the good work that He began in me. The Holy Spirit is working with me. I am not alone.

Paul made a decision not to allow the problems of life and the attacks of religious people to move him off of his course. He chose to go on. He chose to finish his course and fulfill his ministry duties with joy.

Now, some people think that I don't have any problems because I am joyful. They're living in a dream world. Problems come, but I choose joy. I choose to give those problems to God. Is it easy? No. But I refuse to allow worry and anxiety to rob me of my peace and sleep, and I refuse to allow the trouble that is thrown at me to rob my joy. I can get angry, but I don't allow it to go to the point of sin.

I don't walk around in la-la land, but I do choose the path of faith and that gives me great joy. It's by the grace of God and my choice to have faith in God's Word that I continue on my course with joy.

Trouble Comes, But Who Cares?

It doesn't matter what the devil is doing, it's what God says that matters. I tell him, "Devil, if it's a fight you want, then it's a fight you're going to get. Come on, boy! Leap, frog! I'm going to do some damage to you like you've never seen before!" What is my weapon? The Word. I speak the Word to him and it cuts him like a sword. I'm not afraid of him.

If the devil is attacking me, I realize that while it may be tempting to allow my mind to struggle day and night over the situation, I will resist that temptation and give the problem over to God. Why? Because none of these things move me! No mental struggles, no sadness,

no temptation, bonds, or temporary afflictions are going to move me off of my course. The devil will not win. I will maintain my peace. I will maintain my joy. Why? Because God has already given me the victory through the blood of Jesus. Now I'm enforcing the devil's defeat with every situation I go through.

Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world.

1 John 4:4

I'm God's kid! So are you! The Greater One lives in you. The devil is not greater than God. Religious people aren't more powerful than God. Sickness isn't more powerful than God. Neither is debt. No problem can match the power of your God. So why allow these

"things" to move you? Stand up like Paul and say, "None of these things move me."

If God be for you, who can be against you? What can be against you? If you say to that mountain in your life, "Go!" then it has to go. Period. Don't allow trouble to move you. You move trouble! That's what Jesus was saying when He talked about the mountain (Matthew 17:20, 21:21, Mark 11:23). He was trying to show you that you are in control, not the devil. He can fight, yes, but if you resist and use your Sword, he isn't going to defeat you.

Your weapons are far better than the devil's. You're using God's weapons, not your own.

Trouble comes—Jesus said it would in John 16:33: "These things I have spoken unto you, that in Me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but he of good cheer; I have overcome the world."

In other words, keep your joy and stick to the Word for peace. Realize that in this world, trouble comes. But who cares? Rebuke it and go on. Be of good cheer because Jesus has already overcome the world's troubles. When you get a revelation of that, it'll change the way you live your everyday life. Your shoulders will go back and you won't slump over in misery. You won't wring

your hands in worry. You'll realize that the Overcomer lives in you, and there's nothing He can't do!

Not Counting Your Life Dear

In my forty-seven years of ministry, I have been in some crazy situations. I've had people point guns at me while I was preaching. I've had people try and electrocute me while I was preaching on an outdoor platform. I've had a man run at me while I was preaching in a tent and try to cut me with his knife—two deacons attacked the man and knocked him to the ground! Stuff like that doesn't make me stop preaching and go hide in a corner somewhere. I don't miss a lick! I keep preaching. If anything, it just stirs up my righteous indignation. The devil must think I'm making headway for God, so I preach even more.


Once, I was preaching in a tent in my early years of

ministry and a storm blew the poles out from the sides of the tent. The thing collapsed down on me, but I never stopped preaching. I was so fired up that I couldn't stop. I said, "Bless God, though we're covered by canvas, our God is greater than anything else!" I just kept preaching and people were crawling out the tent, so I crawled out, too. They were muddy and I was muddy, but I finished that sermon. Why? Because none of these things move me.

I am going to complete my destiny. I'm going to finish my course with joy. People are going to get saved. I don't count my life so dear

that I would quit preaching just because the devil fights me. Do I enjoy hair-raising experiences like that? Not particularly! I prefer when everything goes right. But if it takes serious evangelism like that, then that's what I'll do.

I've had a crazy woman jump up in service and shake her stupid voodoo doll at me—one that she'd made to look just like me! She had her pin and was just punching the doll with it so I could see her. I said, "Get that crazy demon-possessed woman. Bring her up here and her stinkin' doll, too!" That usher just looked at me. I said, "Grab her!"



He said, "No, that's queen voodoo, man. We don't want to mess with her."

"Get her up here!"

She came up on her own with her little doll. I grabbed the doll, broke the head off, and stomped it on the floor. I rebuked the devil out of her and kept on preaching. You've got to get serious for God when the devil is in your service!

Now, I didn't want to do that. I wanted to sound nice and educated. But the devil's little tactics don't make me tremble. I rebuke him with authority and faith and go on. Why? Because none of these things move me! I stay behind my shield of faith so his darts can't hit me.

A Mark of Character

It's a mark of character to not be easily moved. Feelings change all the time, but the Word doesn't change. The devil sends trouble, but it can't stand the test of time—faith and patience always win. When you choose to not allow the things of life to move you, you're actually building character. It's not fun, but by standing on the Word and not buckling in the heat of battle, your character strengthens. God doesn't send trouble to strengthen you. The devil is the stealer, killer, and destroyer—but you will get stronger by standing on the Word and defeating him. That's a fact!

The devil talks a lot. He makes a big spectacle to try to wave defeat in your face and get you to buckle. He knows you have more power, but it's a mind game to him. He knows that if he can convince you that you're weak, then he's got you. Just remember that all he's got is a big mouth and a mind game—he's roaring as a lion seeking whom he may devour (1 Peter 5:8).

The devil's not a big, burly lion—he's a wannabe! He wanted to be God—he's not. He wants to defeat you—he won't. He's defeated, restricted, rejected, and awaiting confinement. You could say that he is just out on bail until the Lord throws him in the bottomless pit and it is over with.

Affliction at the Hand of People, Not God

When God called me into evangelistic ministry, I didn't get any encouragement from people. They didn't understand how God would ever use me, a Cajun boy, and tried to discourage me from my calling. Mostly, preachers told me, "The devil's gonna beat you and bust you and stomp you and kick your brains out. But if you endure till the end...."

Others would warn me, "You're gonna starve to

death. You're gonna preach a whole week and their gonna steal all your money. They ain't going to give you nothing. You're gonna run out of gas and have to hitchhike home." It was like, "Welcome to the ministry!" I didn't know any different and took their words of "wisdom" and figured that was the way it was going to be. Guess what? They were right. Suffering was coming. But it wasn't going to come at the hand of God; it was going to come at the hand of religious people.

Once, the pastors of a church I was preaching for put me in a Sunday School room and it was 28 degrees inside that room. The church didn't want to put the heater on because they didn't want to pay a higher utility bill. So I had to jog in place all night long not to freeze to death. You'd have thought I was speaking in tongues for all the indecipherable words coming through the walls of that classroom, but it was just my freezing lips and chattering teeth!

Now, it was wrong for them to treat me that way. Even pets are brought inside a heated house when it's that cold. But I thought I was enduring hardness as a good solider (2 Timothy 2:3).

Even as I said that in prayer, God did not answer me. I just thought of Bible characters that endured worse and kept my joy. Many years later I realized that God wasn't in that situation. He didn't cause that affliction; religious men did. God didn't try and freeze me out any more than He wanted the early disciples to be beaten and locked up in jail. Religious men did all that!

These kinds of situations happened over and over again in my early years. I could have quit, but I never did. I'd drive home and my wife would ask me, "Did they take care of you?"

I'd say, "Everything's fine."

"Did you eat?"

"Everything's fine."

I can't tell you how many forced fasts I went on in those years because preachers wouldn't invite me to eat at their homes after the service, or give me any of the offerings they took up (supposedly for me) so I could buy food. Many times I'd go to preach a Sunday through Friday meeting and one of the first things they'd tell me was, "We're all on a weeklong fast." I wouldn't complain or argue because, honestly, I was just so excited to preach and figured that any hardship I endured, even forced fasting, was just what I had to do to serve Jesus.

Once, a preacher asked me to come and minister for nine days. When I got there, I was given ten dollars for the whole nine days for my meals and was told, "If you go to Popeye's Fried Chicken down the street and you buy a Coke, they'll give you a free biscuit." Now, I am flesh and blood. I get hungry. And when I preach, I give my all. Afterwards, I can eat a lot, but that week I went hungry. But I didn't complain and I didn't preach with any less joy or enthusiasm. Why? Because even though there were hard times, I decided that to do it for Jesus was worth it—none of these things could move me.

Another time a preacher invited me to speak for the week, and at the end he shook my hand and thanked me—that's it! I didn't have any money for gas to get home. I had enough to get to a gas station just outside of town, where a convenience store worker was kind enough to give me the bottom kernels from the popcorn bin. It was the first I'd eaten in a week!

Now, my character grew because I chose to stand on the Word even when I was being treated badly and wronged by people who knew better, but it wasn't God Who was testing me. God tests no man. He loved me and would have preferred that I'd be in a warm place when it was freezing outside. He would have preferred that I'd eat when I was hungry, and that I'd fast when He told me to fast—not some stingy preacher who just didn't want to give me anything and wanted to keep the offering for the church or himself.

Many years of my ministry were marked by tests, trials, and afflictions—not at the hand of God but at the hand of religious people. Those who came to the meetings were very kind and many were supportive. That time at the gas station, God actually used an unsaved man to help me—he came to the gas station, started asking me questions, and then filled up my car for free. He told me to go into the store and get all the food I wanted. God provided for me and He used a cussing heathen to do it! God will even use the unsaved when He can't get through to Christians.

You see, I was always so excited that God would call me to preach the Gospel that I'd endure anything—and it was a good way to be because even though Christians treated me wrong, God honored me.

But I came to realize later on that the only one God wished to endure pain and suffering was Jesus when He was on the cross, because that's what was needed so we could receive redemption and salvation—spiritually, physically, emotionally, and even financially. Much of the time, it is man's inhumanity to man that causes trials and tribulations.

Men who do wrong are not motivated by God's

spirit but by their own flesh and the evil spirits manipulating them. "For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places" (Ephesians 6:12). The devil was trying to use the church to squeeze me out of the ministry, and he used religious men to do it.

Knowing a God-Thing When You See It

The devil tried to work on my insecurities with speaking, too. I never felt worthy to preach. I knew my English was bad and that Cajuns weren't looked upon highly. I knew that my past was bad and that I wasn't a typical type of preacher. But I also knew I was called and whether anybody thought highly of me or not, I had to follow my calling.

I'd ask God, "Lord, do You realize who I am?" "Yeah."

"But I don't know how to do this, God."

He said, "That's why I'm calling you."

"No, You don't understand. I don't know how to do this."

"Yeah, but you aren't easily moved. I can count on you, boy. I don't care if it's cold or hot, you're there."

"Oh yeah." I said, "I'm on Your side, Jesus. I'm on Your side."

That's just the way I was. If there was one thing I had, it was tenacity and God saw that in me. Whatever pain there was, it didn't make a difference as long as I fulfilled my calling. But I went through some pretty tough things in the ministry. People would ask me, "How's the ministry going, Jesse?"

"FINE! Whooooa! God's good! They're staying away by the thousands! I had the biggest stay-away meeting you ever saw in your life!" I'd make jokes like that and not rehearse the bad times.

But even though I made jokes, inside I still wouldn't allow discouragement over something man did to steal my joy over what God was going to do. It was a test of character not to be easily moved.

You see, I knew a God-thing when I saw it. God wanted me to preach the Gospel to those people—they needed it! He didn't put me through that—it was Christians who were doing wrong. God wasn't trying to teach me something—the devil was trying to defeat me and get me to give up on the ministry. I want you to really understand that because it'll help you if you're going through tests and trials.

I believe that God sent me to be a blessing to those people, and He wanted them to be a blessing to me, too. It wasn't God's fault that they didn't obey Him. Those pastors had free will and could choose to obey God or not. What they didn't realize is that they were sowing seeds that would come back to them—they would never have the ministry they really wanted because they refused to support others. Greed choked their success.

But by giving my all in the midst of being wronged and by standing on the Word in the midst of trials, I was sowing seeds that would one day come back to me—and let me tell you something, those seeds have sprung up 30, 60 and 100-fold! God has blessed me with a worldwide ministry and so many blessings that I can hardly count them. The point? God is faithful even when people aren't.

Covenant-Minded People

However, even in those early years, there were people that recognized the call of God on my life and began to support me. Most were the people who came to see me preach. They began to support me by praying for me regularly and coming to the services when I was nearby. Some drove hundreds of miles just to be in the meetings. I was amazed by that!

I'd set up my table with a tape duplicator to copy the sermon, run up to the front and preach, pray for people, and then go back to the table to duplicate the tapes. They'd come and buy the sermon, and little by little they started giving donations to my ministry. They were covenant-minded and we had the same vision. These were my first Covenant Partners, and let me tell you something, they were godsent.

These people saw the call on my life. They believed in the vision God gave me. They knew I was a man of conviction, that I was honorable and doing my best to do what God called me to do. Some people attack prosperity and think that offerings and partnership aren't a good thing. They attack the prosperity message, but the truth is that God meant this message for these last days—to speed up the rate in which we evangelize this world.

Sure, there are greedy preachers out there and it doesn't take a rocket scientist to spot them. But not all ministers are greedy and many are doing a great work for God. People are hearing the Word and getting born again—saved and filled with the Holy Ghost! This is what changes lives. It's the message we're spreading that is making the difference. God is meeting people where they are, even if that is in their living rooms through the TV and bringing them out of darkness and into His light.

In the beginning of my ministry, the kind of people

who gave to my ministry were like Lazarus, Mary, and Martha. They provided for me and helped me to continue in ministry when preachers would not obey God. Like Jesus' supporters, these people believed in the work enough to support it. I didn't take it lightly way back then, and I still don't today.

Today I call my Lazarus', Mary's, and Martha's "Covenant Partners." Why? Because they're in union with me to get this Gospel preached. I'm thankful for every one of them, and I believe that when we all get to Heaven, they'll have people on their front lawn saying, "Thank you for sending Jesse! I got saved after hearing him, so I'm here because of you." There is no greater reward than that.

Don't Let These Things Move You

I don't flinch over sin, sickness, disease, depression, debt, or any other thing from the pit of hell. If I see a woman or a man who's doing all sorts of sin, I don't let the knowledge of their sin move me—I still believe that the blood of Jesus is more than enough to get rid of it.

If I see someone who is sick and dying, I don't let the knowledge of their sickness or the sight of their body move me—I pray for their healing and expect results. Why? Because none of these things move me. This is how we, as Christians, should be thinking. Like Paul, we should realize that no matter what, serving Christ and witnessing for Jesus is the most important thing.

There are so many "things" going on in the world today, and people need Jesus like never before. Yet Christians are being persecuted for sharing their faith and living by their principles. Sin is so common today and people are so complacent about it that you'd think we were living in ancient Rome. Even our nightly news is filled with horrible acts of people stealing from one another, killing each other, and destroying each other's lives.

You may be experiencing some of it firsthand and it could ruin your joy and peace if you let it. Or it could make you feel like situations and people are so bad that nothing can turn them around, but that's a lie from the devil. The blood of Jesus can wash away any sin, cause a heart-change in any person, and the Word can wipe out any problem. That's why it's important for you to look at the problems and not be moved by them. God is still God and He can do miracles.

Today, you can stare the devil in the eye and spit. You don't have to move an inch. You can look at those problems in your life and say, "None of these things move ME! Devil, no matter what you say or do, I've already won!"

Friend, if you're struggling and battling through a difficult time, I want to tell you that Jesus is your answer. Only He can take care of your problems, and He's ready and willing to come into your life today. The Father sent His Son Jesus to earth to die for your sins, and He rose again not only to give you eternal life in Heaven, but also a victorious life here and now.

John 3:16 says, "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life." As you say these words with your mouth and believe them with your heart, you will be born again (Romans 10:9-10):

Jesus, come into my life. Forgive me of all my sins. I ask You to cleanse my heart and make me a new person in You right now. I believe that You are the Son of God and that You died on the cross for me.



In the fifty years since I have been serving my Lord Jesus Christ, I have had many glorious moments. Each one of them have made an impact on my life, but none was so great as the moment that I gave my life to Jesus while watching Billy Graham on television. Instantly, my heart was flooded with God's amazing love and I was never the same again. One moment I was lost, and the next I was found. One moment my life was hopeless, and the next my life had unlimited possibilities. One moment I was indifferent to God, and the next all I wanted to think about was God, His Word, spending time with Him in prayer and advancing the Gospel that had totally transformed my life. I was a relentless believer!

I constantly looked for opportunities to advance the Gospel and my heathen husband was my primary target. I had Jesse in my crosshairs and knew it was just a matter of time before he would be born again and we would serve the Lord together. I was relentless about praying for him to come to church with me, hoping he would go down to the altar and accept Jesus. However, the few times that Jesse did agree to come with me to church did not bring the results that I had hoped.

That first time was a big disappointment. Jesse saw several people in the church that were drunk the night before in the nightclub where he worked as an entertainer. Their hypocrisy became his new excuse to reject the Gospel—complaining that the church was full of hypocrites. Later, when his favorite uncle talked to

him about giving his life to the Lord, Jesse used that same excuse. His uncle was also relentless and told him, "You've got to be smaller than a hypocrite to hide behind one."

Several months later, we went to our hometown to visit family and I convinced Jesse to go to church again. I hoped this would be the moment that he would respond to the Gospel. Jesse behaved himself during the worship and during the sermon, but everything went south when that pastor pointed

at Jesse and yelled, "Hey you with the long hair in the back. Do you want to get saved?" That pastor's question sent Jesse into orbit and he started hurling curse words at that pastor and threatened to whip him to a pulp. Thankfully, Jesse's brother Wayne had come with us to church and together we yanked Jesse out of there before he could hit that pastor.

That was the last straw for Jesse and he told me that he would never go to church again. That's when I went into stealth mode—I quietly laid my hands on him while he slept and rebuked the devil from blinding his eyes to the truth and commanded the light of the Gospel to shine on him (2 Corinthians 4:4). I also stood proxy for his salvation in every prayer line at church and sowed financial seeds into ministries that were reaching the lost. I wasn't paying for Jesse's salvation, but I believed that if I helped someone else's loved one hear the Gospel, then God would watch over my seed and send laborers into His harvest to reach Jesse and change his life (Matthew 9:38). I was a relentless sower!

I am so grateful for Billy Graham and the faithful partners that helped him preach the Gospel on television the night that Jesse was born again. One moment he was lost, and the next he was asking Jesus

to forgive his sins and come into his life. One moment he was bound by drugs and alcohol, and the next he was instantly delivered. One moment he was blind to the Gospel, and the next he saw the truth. The impact of that television broadcast not only changed Jesse's life, it also changed millions of lives that have been impacted by the Gospel throughout our forty-seven years of ministry. We are relentless ministers of the Gospel.

The Cambridge
Dictionary defines the word
relentless as: "continuing in a
determined way, without any

interruption." In The Oxford Dictionary it is defined as, "unceasingly intense." A few of the synonyms are "persistent, unwavering, single minded, continuous, nonstop." I am married to an unceasingly intense person. Jesse is relentless, and so am I. We are perfectly matched. We are both relentless about advancing the vision—reaching people and changing lives, one soul at a time.

While preaching recently, Jesse said, "I refuse to stop running!" That statement really grabbed

my heart, so I wrote it down, but I added these other words to it in my notepad that day: "I am a relentless runner. I am a relentless believer. I am a relentless worker. I'm a relentless servant of Jesus Christ. I'm a relentless leader. I'm a relentless pastor. I am a relentless visionary." I believe that the relentless advance toward God's plan and purpose for their lives.

A RELENTLESS SAVIOR

God always gives us visions that are much bigger than us. He wants us to advance toward our glorious future—always stretching to move farther and higher than where we are today. Too often we get stuck in life because we focus on our past experiences or our present circumstances. But God is calling us to be relentless in our pursuit of His vision for His creation. All of us have an integral part in the plan of God and we all need to be committed to what God has called us to do.

Hebrews12:1-4 says, "Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus the Author and Finisher of our faith; Who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. For consider Him that endured such contradiction of sinners against Himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds. Ye have not yet resisted unto blood, striving against sin."

When you get weary with the problems of life, consider what Jesus endured on the cross for you. If you start feeling faint in your mind, look at the Author and Finisher of your faith and run your race with patience. You are not in this alone—you have a relentless Savior!

Hebrews 12:12-13 in the Amplified Bible, Classic Edition says, "So then, brace up and reinvigorate and set right your slackened and weakened and drooping hands and strengthen your feeble and palsied and tottering knees, And cut through and make firm and plain and smooth, straight paths for your feet [yes, make them safe and upright and happy paths that go in the right direction], so that the lame and halting [limbs] may not be put out of joint, but rather may be cured."

This verse is like a swift kick in the pants. It is a wakeup call for the relentless advance of your vision. Regardless of how impossible your situation may be, this verse is a challenge to brace up, reinvigorate, set right, and be strengthened to make firm, plain, smooth, straight, safe, upright, and happy paths for your life.

That is what our relentless Savior did during His earthly ministry. Jesus encountered opposition from every direction, but He did not allow it to stop or change His path. Luke 9:51 says that He "steadfastly set His face to go to Jerusalem." Jesus was relentless in His passion to advance toward His destiny.

Isaiah 50:7 says, "For the Lord God will help me; therefore shall I not be confounded: therefore have I set my face like a flint, and I know that I shall not be ashamed." This prophetic verse reveals the opposition to Jesus and His determination to stay focused. The Dake's Bible defines the term "set my face like a flint" to mean that Jesus was courageous, firm, and resolved to accomplish a certain thing in spite of all the scorn and hatred heaped upon Him. When all the forces of hell came against Jesus, He was courageous, firm, and resolved. He is a relentless Savior.

A RELENTLESS WOMAN

Jesus Christ came to give us answers to the problems that we encounter in life. In John 10:10, He exposed the devil's plan is to steal, kill, and destroy everything that God created. Jesus also revealed to the world that He came to give us a life that is abundant, overflowing, and enjoyable. He also taught us to always pray and never faint, lose heart, or give up with His powerful parable about a relentless woman.

Luke 18:2-5 (AMPC) says, "He said, In a certain city there was a judge who neither reverenced and feared God nor respected or considered man. And there was a widow in that city who kept coming to him and saying, Protect and defend and give me justice against my adversary. And for a time he would not; but later he said to himself, Though I have neither reverence or fear for God nor respect or consideration for man, Yet because this widow continues to bother me, I will defend and protect and avenge her, lest she give me intolerable annoyance and wear me out by her continual coming or at the last she come and rail on me or assault me or strangle me."

Jesus makes it clear that this unjust judge was totally intimidated by a relentless woman and gave her exactly what she needed! He was convinced that she would be unceasingly intense and continue to come at him in a determined way without any interruption.

Verses 6-8 say, "Then the Lord sayeth, Listen to what the unjust judge says! And will not [our just] God, defend and protect and avenge His elect (His chosen ones), who cry to Him day and night?" Will He defer them and delay help on their behalf? I tell you, He will defend and protect and avenge them speedily. However, when the Son of Man comes, will He find [persistence in] faith on the earth?" That's the kind of persistence in faith that Jesus will look for when He returns to the earth.

A RELENTLESS PRAYER

In the eleventh chapter of Luke, Jesus taught His disciple's how to pray and then gave them an example of relentless prayer. Verses 5-8 say, "And He said unto them, Which of you shall have a friend, and shall go unto

him at midnight, and say unto him, Friend, lend me three loaves; For a friend of mine in his journey is come to me, and I have nothing to set before him? And he from within shall answer and say, Trouble me not: the door is now shut, and my children are with me in bed; I cannot rise and give thee. I say unto you, Though he will not rise and give him, because he is his friend, yet because of his importunity he will rise and give him as many as he needeth."

The Amplified Bible,

Classic Edition of verse eight gave me a clearer understanding of the word *importunity*. It says, "...yet because of his shameless persistence and insistence he will get up and give him as much as he needs."

Jesus used this example to teach us about relentless prayer and said, "So I say to you, Ask and keep on asking and it shall be given to you; seek and keep on seeking and you shall find; knock and keep on knocking

and the door shall be opened to you. For everyone who asks and keeps on asking receives..." (Luke 11:9-10). That's relentless asking. That's relentless seeking. That's relentless knocking.

Verse 13 goes on to say, "If you then, evil as you are, know how to give good gifts, [gifts that are to their advantage] to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask and continue to ask Him!"

God's desire to give good gifts to His children is much greater than we can even imagine. He knows what we have need of before we ask, but His Word instructs us to ask, seek, and knock. We must be a relentless knocker, a relentless seeker, and a relentless finder.

God has given us a voice for a reason. So often we listen to what the enemy says and we repeat it. But God wants us to speak life into dead, non-existent things and breathe mouth-to-mouth resuscitation into the dreams and the visions that He has placed in our hearts.

Never sabotage your future with your own words. Dreams and visions do not have an expiration date. It's time for you to shake the dust off and start talking to it. God's Word in your heart and in your mouth are containers that will shape your future. And when you declare it, you're going to see a big change in your life.

Be bold and use your voice to declare what you want in your life. "I am

relentless! I advance toward my goal! God's promise will come to pass! I refuse to back up! I'm going forward and I'm going to receive everything God has promised!"

We are all called to be relentless members of an unshakeable kingdom. It's time to take back our families, our hope, our vision, and everything that God has promised. The relentless never faint, lose heart, or give up. The relentless advance the Gospel!
