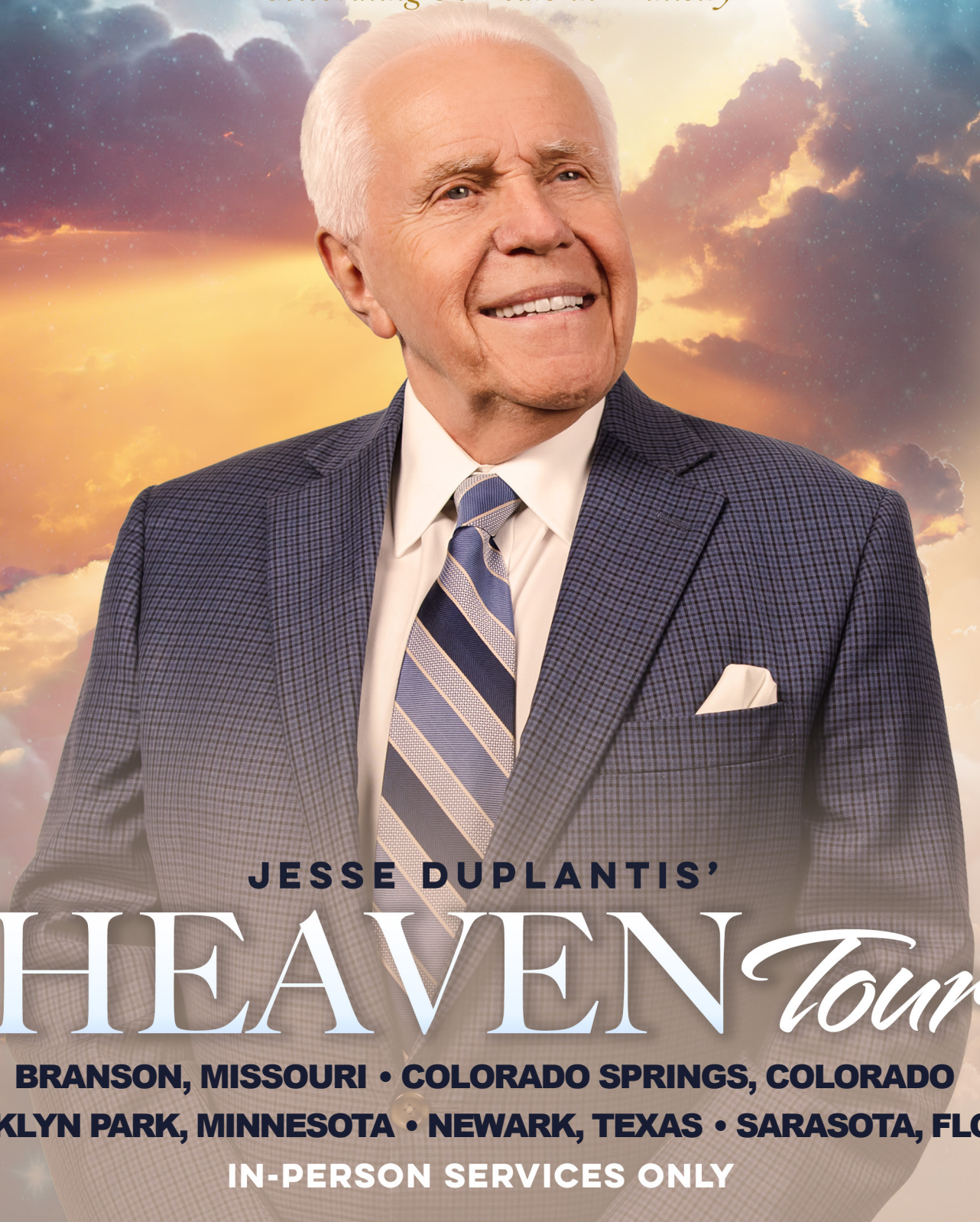

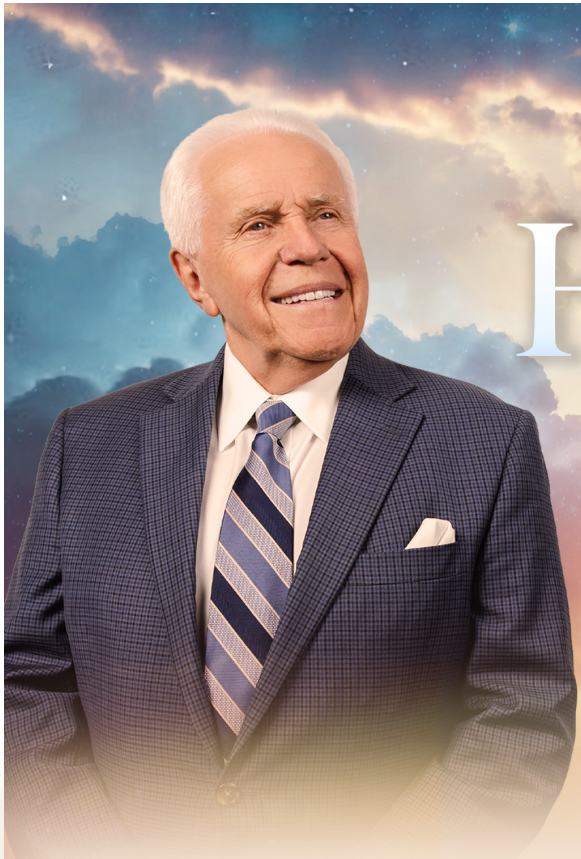

Dead Man Walking, LIVE MAN *Rising*

JESSE DUPLANTIS

My mother went home to be with Jesus on Easter Sunday in 1982. She was a powerful woman of faith and saw many miracles in her day. Today, many people know me by two things: my white hair and my teeth—both of which came from my mother.

Now, my mother didn't have great teeth. In fact, most of them fell out—she had to wear dentures. But I *do* have perfect teeth. It's just the truth. In fact, my teeth have been used to create dentures for other people. Years ago, a dentist took a mold of my mouth to use as an example of what a good set should look like, and told me he was going to use them to mold dentures. So, people may be walking around today with my choppers!

But what most people don't know is that my teeth came at a price—the price of faith. You see, my mother did not have money, but she had faith that her God could do anything.

When I was a little boy, I had what some call “milk teeth.” My teeth were ruined from sucking a bottle too long, and I mean *way* too long. I dragged a bottle around with me until I was six years old. You read right...six! I loved milk and I loved the bottle, and I flat refused to give it up even when I stopped sucking from it. Instead, I'd just unscrew the top and drink from the bottle like it was a jar. I'd take it to school with me. I'm not kidding!

After awhile, it ruined my teeth. They were rotting away, and my front teeth were actually growing out the middle of my pallet. It was bad. So, Mama took me to the dentist and the dentist said, “Uh, Mrs. Duplantis, that boy's going to have very crooked teeth.” He explained the situation to her further and then said, “I'm going to pull these four baby teeth.” Then, he pointed to my front teeth and said, “They're going to come forward, but they're going to come in crooked. He's going to need all kinds of work.”

Mama said, “Well, I don't have that kind of money.” The dentist said, “Well, it's going to take that kind of money to do it.” Mama immediately said, “Well, I shall pray to the Physician of physicians.” I remember sitting in that dentist's office thinking, *Oh, here we go with this God stuff.* Well, we left and Mama prayed. She said, “Lord, I don't have the money, but I command those teeth to come forward.”

Now, those teeth didn't come forward in the first day, by no means. It took about eight months, but that didn't deter my mother. She kept praying, and those teeth kept moving. At first, I was kind of worried because I started to look like a little rabbit. I could see them coming out and forward, and I thought, *God, I hope they stop cause then I'm going to look like a little nutria rat by the time it's all finished.*

So, I said, “Mama, can you make them stop?” Mama

said, “Yeah, the Lord will make them stop.” And He did. Glory to God, I’ve got a miracle mouth! No braces and no retainers, just the miraculous power of God. Did it come at a price? It cost my mother the prayer of faith and the diligence of faith—the strong and steady belief that God could do anything if she would only believe.

God has done many miracles in my life—I’ve been healed of paralyzed legs, and God has saved my life numerous times—and I just don’t have the space in this article to tell you of all the times God has done amazing things. But I do want you to know this: God can do *anything* if you will believe Him. You may have bad teeth, paralyzed legs, or deadness in your spirit or body...it doesn’t matter. God’s power is limitless!

Resurrection Power

The Easter holiday represents a whole lot more than candy and chocolate rabbits, even though we like that stuff a lot! It’s a holiday founded on the **power** of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. Think about that for a moment. Raising the dead is a serious miracle. You sure don’t see too much of it happening today. Most of us think about raising the dead and just flinch. Why? Because our faith isn’t up for it. But *Jesus* was full of faith and power, and He had no problem with raising the dead at all.

Not long ago, I began to think about this, and I wondered how Jesus could be so sure that He would rise again. I wondered how Jesus could be so certain that He’d be *able* to come out of His tomb. Think about it. Nobody ever laid hands on Jesus. Nobody ever prayed over Him and commanded life back into His body. He was as dead as a doornail, wrapped the traditional way of burial, lying in a big tomb with a huge stone rolled over the door, and yet He came out of the grave.

The more I thought about Jesus’ faith in Himself to be raised, the more I started to realize something pretty simple: Before Jesus ever raised Himself from the dead, He did a little practicing first.

Practicing on Dead People

That’s right! Jesus raised dead people long before He was ever condemned to the cross.

Remember the widow’s son in Luke 7? Practice.

Remember Jairus’ daughter in Luke 8? Practice.

How about the most famous one, Lazarus, in John 11? Practice.

Maybe Jesus thought, *If I can get them out, I can get Me out!* Oh, I can’t prove that’s what He thought, but you can’t prove that He didn’t.

As I considered this, it dawned on me that Jesus *never* seemed to doubt that He would come out of the grave. Even that big stone rolled in front of the tomb didn’t seem to be a problem. Why? I believe it is because Jesus had faith

in Himself and His Father. He knew that He was *more* than able to be raised from the dead, without any human intervention or help. *That’s* the power of the Lord at work—the power of the great big God we serve!

A Greater Miracle

Jesus had some wonderful friends named Martha, Mary, and Lazarus. These people loved Jesus and totally enjoyed His ministry. They were siblings, and they did all they could to help Jesus get His message out. They supported His work financially, gave Him a nice room to rest in when He came into town to preach, and prayed for His ministry, too. Martha, Mary, and Lazarus were not only His partners, but also His close friends.

When Lazarus got sick, it was Martha who sent word to Jesus to come and lay hands on her brother. But Jesus didn’t do what Martha wanted Him to do. The Bible says that He stayed two more days in the place where He was before He left for Martha’s house in Judea.

When Jesus decided to go, His disciples warned Him that He’d be stoned if He went back to Judea. Jesus wasn’t deterred. “...*Our friend Lazarus sleepeth;*” He said, “*but I go, that I may awake him out of sleep*” (John 11:11).

The disciples misunderstood. “*Then said His disciples, Lord, if he sleep, he shall do well*” (John 11:12). You see, Jesus knew by the Spirit of God that Lazarus had already died; the disciples thought that Lazarus was resting and, therefore, getting better. Jesus set them straight: “*Then said Jesus unto them plainly, Lazarus is dead*” (John 11:14).

That’s pretty strong, isn’t it? Lazarus is dead—end of statement! Jesus was a direct man. Then He told the disciples something that seems kind of strange: “*And I am glad for your sakes that I was not there, to the intent ye may believe; nevertheless let us go unto him*” (John 11:15). Why would Jesus say that He was glad that He wasn’t there? Because a greater miracle was going to happen because of it. The disciples were going to start really believing...and, to Jesus, that was a greater miracle than healing Lazarus’ sick body.

You see, this was about more than Lazarus, even though Christ loved Lazarus very much. It was about Christ bringing glory to God and teaching His disciples a lesson as well. Jesus wanted His followers to recognize that God could do anything. He wanted them to know that His power was beyond merely healing the sick; it was also about raising the dead.

Christ wanted the disciples to see this type of amazing miracle practiced on others so that they would believe in an even greater miracle—the Resurrection of Jesus Himself.

Thomas’ Fearless Faith

Now, this is the part of the story of Lazarus that I just love and think is often overlooked: “*Then said Thomas, which is called Didymus, unto his fellowdisciples, Let us also go, that*

we may die with Him" (John 11:16).

We always think of Thomas as "Doubting Thomas" because he had a moment of weakness after Christ died and rose from the dead. Although he witnessed the resurrection of Lazarus, he wanted to touch Christ's wound before believing that He had risen. But what we see here is that this man wasn't a doubter his *entire* life! He was a man of faith. Think about it. The rest of the disciples were warning Jesus that He might be stoned to death if He returned to Judea, but Thomas said, and I'm paraphrasing, 'Man, if He's gonna die, we're gonna die with Him!' In other words, 'I'm with You, Jesus!'

Thomas demonstrated fearless faith when the other disciples wanted to run the other way.

Martha's Limit

Now Bethany was nigh unto Jerusalem, about fifteen furlongs off:

And many of the Jews came to Martha and Mary, to comfort them concerning their brother.

Then Martha, as soon as she heard that Jesus was coming, went and met Him: but Mary sat still in the house.

Then said Martha unto Jesus, Lord, if Thou hadst been here, my brother had not died.

But I know, that even now, whatsoever Thou wilt ask of God, God will give it Thee.

John 11:18-22

Martha had some faith and she really believed in Jesus. When she heard He was coming, she ran to meet Him, and the first words that came out of her mouth were words of faith: "...*Lord, if Thou hadst been here, my brother had not died*" (v. 21). In other words, she believed that Jesus had the ability to heal the sick, but maybe not the ability to raise the dead.

You see, there are different levels of faith. Some people have the faith to heal the sick, but there aren't too many that have the faith to raise the dead. Then you can see Martha's thinking shift into greater faith in verse 22: "*But I know, that even now, whatsoever Thou wilt ask of God, God will give it Thee.*"

Now she was doing good, but why did Martha think that God would do anything Christ asked? Maybe it's because she heard Jesus say so. How many times have you said that? Are you as sure as Jesus was that God answers prayer? Think about it. You see, Martha knew that prayer wasn't a gamble with Christ but an assurance.

That's how you can tell when you're growing to the fullness of the stature of Christ—it's when you move from seeing God as a gamble to having complete assurance in

His ability and will to perform His Word. You're growing in faith when you move from "I'm believing" into "I know!"

Resurrection Power

Jesus responded to Martha with five simple words of faith: "*Jesus saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise again*" (John 11:23).

Now, you'd think Martha would have been hopeful at these words, but, instead, Martha flinched. Remember, raising the dead was not a common occurrence. So, when Jesus said this, Martha's religious mindset kicked in and she immediately put a limit on God: "*Martha saith unto Him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day*" (John 11:24).

Do you see what happened? Martha shifted from faith to religion because what Jesus said was extreme. Now remember, the first thing she told Jesus was that if He'd been there earlier, He could have healed her brother. Then, her faith kicked up a notch and she said she knew that even at that moment, the Father would do whatever Jesus asked. But when confronted with a radical miracle, she shifted back to limiting God's power by saying she knew her brother would rise at the end of time when everyone is resurrected.

What was going on with Martha? She was wavering because what Christ was saying was not normal, even in the realm of faith. It was extreme. It was radical. It was hard to believe, even if it was coming out of the mouth of the Son of God.

“*Jesus said unto her, I am the Resurrection, and the Life: he that believeth in Me, though he were dead, yet shall he live.*” John 11:25

She believed that Jesus could heal her brother, but raising her brother from the dead was too much. But notice, Christ did not flinch even in the face of Martha's doubt: "*Jesus said unto her, I am the Resurrection, and the Life: he that believeth in Me, though he were dead, yet shall he live*" (John 11:25).

Martha expected a future resurrection, but Jesus surprised her with a present resurrection in Himself. Now, I could preach forever on Christ's two words, "I am!" Jesus didn't flinch because He knew Who He was and He knew the God that He served—the Great I AM! So Christ didn't say, "I

believe I am.” He didn’t say “I *think* I am.” He said, “**I am the Resurrection,**” and notice that there’s a comma there. In other words, pause and think about it! Then there’s a colon: “**I am the Resurrection, and the Life:**” So, when you see that colon, you should pause and think about *that* a while longer! Jesus *IS* the Resurrection power. Jesus *IS* the Life. “*And whosoever liveth and believeth in Me shall never die...*” (John 11:26).

Jesus wanted Martha to know that the power was present, and if she wanted to draw from it, she needed to believe. So, He posed a simple but profound question to Martha. He said, “...*Believest thou this?*” (v.26).

Jesus wanted to know if Martha believed that He was the Resurrection and the Life. “*She saith unto Him, Yea, Lord: I believe that Thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world. And when she had so said, she went her way...*” (John 11:27-28).

You see, that’s the rule of faith: If you don’t believe, it’s not going to happen for you. Christ already has the faith to believe in Himself. He *knows* what He can do because the very power of creation is within Him. It’s *your* faith added to *His* power that brings about miracles. But just like Jesus asked Martha in John 11:26, you must also ask yourself: “*Believest thou this?*” It’s what *you* believe that’s going to make the difference.

Jesus *IS* the Resurrection and the Life. If He said it, you can believe it. Get to the point that you *know* it, and when you pray for something, you are assured. If you do that, then you *will* rise up out of your situation. You will *see* the goodness of the Lord at work in your life.

Jesus *IS* the power, and the power is always present... *that’s* the miracle of the Resurrection for you and me. It’s the same power that created the heavens and the earth, and it’s the same power that raised the widow’s son, Jairus’ daughter, and Lazarus from the deadness of their physical bodies. It’s that same power that raised Jesus from the dead and it really does dwell in YOU.

Creed for the Memory, Christ for the Heart

Martha’s creed was to consider her brother’s rising on resurrection day, but I like to say this: **Creeds are good for the memory, but Christ is good for the heart.** Christ wanted to change the situation and use Lazarus’ death to display the glory of God.

After Martha’s conversation with Christ, she immediately went home to her sister, Mary, and told her to go see Jesus. Mary went straight away, but when she saw Jesus, she fell down at His feet crying through the very same words that Martha had spoken, “...*Lord, if Thou hadst been here, my brother had not died*” (John 11:32). The sadness of it all touched Christ’s heart.

When Jesus therefore saw her weeping, and the Jews also weeping which came with her, He groaned in the spirit, and was troubled, And said, Where have ye laid him? They said unto Him, Lord, come and see. Jesus wept.

John 11:33-35

Jesus was a man of like-passions, as we are. It hurt Him to see their pain. It troubled Jesus enough to groan in the spirit and weep publicly.

Then said the Jews, Behold how He loved him! And some of them said, Could not this Man, which opened the eyes of the blind, have caused that even this man should not have died?

Jesus therefore again groaning in Himself cometh to the grave. It was a cave, and a stone lay upon it.

Jesus said, Take ye away the stone...

John 11:36-39

That stone...it represents trouble to me. In life, it just always seems like there is a big stone standing in the way of a miracle. Remember, man will always put a stone in your way, but God will always roll it away. People will try and shut you up and shut you down, but God will roll that thing away and let you breathe fresh air.

Christ commanded the stone to be rolled away.

Dead Men Stink

Here’s the part I love. “...*Martha, the sister of him that was dead, saith unto Him, Lord, by this time he stinketh: for he hath been dead four days*” (John 11:39). Martha was concerned with the stench!

Well, if you think Lazarus stunk to high heaven, you should have smelled me. I was dead twenty-four and a half years before I came to know Christ! Do you think I stunk? You better know it! My soul reeked. But Christ approached me, and as we know from the Bible, **no one ever died in the presence of Christ, and no one remained dead when He approached them.**

When Christ approached me, I was sitting on the edge of a bed in a hotel room just killing time before I was going to play a rock show. Cathy had the TV tuned to a Billy Graham evangelistic crusade. It was Labor Day weekend in 1974, and I had long, chocolate brown hair. But as I sat on the bed watching that television, Jesus began to approach me...and when He did, my deadness became more and more apparent.

When I released myself into God's hands and said, "Lord, I don't know if You're real or not, but if You are, come into my life," something happened. I rose up! I became a new creature in Christ. Glory! It was my resurrection day, and although I'd been living without God for twenty-four and a half years and my soul stunk of the deadness of this world, Jesus took me, washed me in His blood, and made me clean. Glory to God!

You see, time has nothing to do with it. When it comes to your spirit, you can be dead for nearly all your life, and on your very last breath you can ask Christ to come into your heart and you will rise up. And when it comes to the physical body, always remember that God started with dust when He made Adam. He can handle dust!

In Lazarus' case, Jesus knew that Martha's worries were just that...worries! Four days of being in the grave is nothing when you're talking about the power of the living God. That day was Lazarus' time to rise up!

Jesus saith unto her, Said I not unto thee, that, if thou wouldst believe, thou shouldst see the glory of God?

Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead was laid. And Jesus lifted up His eyes, and said, Father, I thank Thee that Thou hast heard Me.

And I knew that Thou hearest Me always: but because of the people which stand by I said it, that they may believe that Thou hast sent Me.

*And when He thus had spoken, He cried with a loud voice, **Lazarus, come forth.***

John 11:40-43

And Lazarus came forth. He was a symbol to everyone that the power of God rested upon the life of Jesus Christ—the power to heal, to deliver, to cast out demons, and to raise the dead. That is the power that Christ promised the disciples they would walk in after His death.

Loose and Let Them Go!

To be risen from spiritual death, however, is the greatest miracle of all because it goes beyond the mortal body. It frees a person to forever be with God, even after physical death. But do you know that you can be raised from the dead spiritually, yet still be bound? You can be saved by the power of Christ and yet still be bound by the tight trappings of life. That's where the Church comes in.

You see, Lazarus *did* come forth. Life rushed back into his body and he physically rose from the dead. Glory! But look at what John 11:44 says Jesus commanded the people around Him to do: *And he that was dead came forth, bound*

hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go."

Who did Jesus tell to loose Lazarus so that he could go? *Them...* the people who were present. You see, in the spiritual aspect of this message, I want you to realize this: It is the responsibility of the Church—the people of God who witness spiritual resurrection—to *loose* those who get saved by the power of God so that they can *go*. God wants His kids to fly like eagles, but we can't do it if we're still bound by the graveclothes of our old life.

It's time for the people of God to say, "Wait a minute! Churches are not designed by God to put ropes and chains on people. God is not into legalism. He said that whom the Son has set free, is free indeed!" It's my responsibility as a preacher to preach the message of loosing and letting go. That's why I live for Jesus daily, not just on Sunday or Easter Sunday. This is a lifestyle of loosing and letting go. The only Jesus some people may ever see is the Jesus in you, or the Jesus in me. I say that often because it's the truth.

Christ has saved us. He's raised us up from our deadness and given us a new life, spiritually. We're in this together. It's His great pleasure to give us this life and let us enjoy it, but it's also His command that we help others to get out of the tangles of this life. Glory to God! He can do the work, but He wants our help. That's what Christ was trying to show the disciples that day, and that's what He wants to show us today, too.

Don't Let Them Kill You Again

But let me warn you, even if you were raised by God from the deadness of a life without Him, other people will try and put you back in the grave again. They will try and wrap you up and put you out.

Just look at what happened to Lazarus: *"But the chief priests consulted that they might put Lazarus also to death; Because that by reason of him many of the Jews went away, and believed on Jesus"* (John 12:10-11). They said, and I'm paraphrasing, 'We're gonna have to kill him!' Why? Because they didn't like the reputation that the miracle brought Jesus.

You see, it's all about Christ. When people want to drag you down, it's because they don't want the life of Christ to be seen. They'd rather you be dead to God's ways because it's more comfortable for them; but that's not what Christ has designed for you. So, don't let them put you back in the grave.

Some people may feel the need to crush your faith in God. Let them say what they will, but don't let them rob you. Recognize that whether they know it or not, they're being influenced by the devil to rob you of your life—to put you down while you're rising up. Don't let them stomp out your faith in God. Christ's words and actions let us know this simple truth: God can do *anything* if we'll give Him our lives and only believe. 🌐

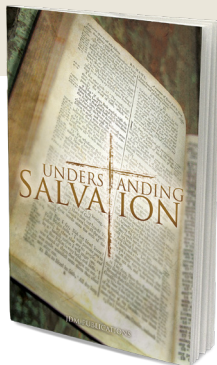

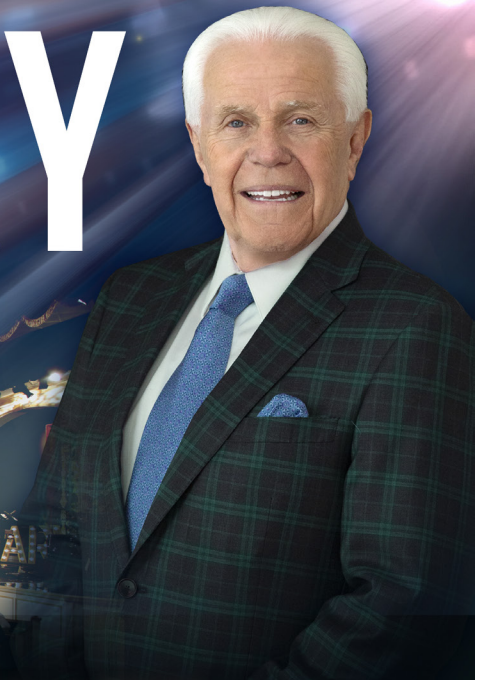

SHOUT FOR JOY AND BE GLAD! GOD IS GOOD, AND HIS BLESSINGS ARE FOR YOU!

“Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of His servant.” (Psalm 35:27)

**Below is an excerpt from Jesse Duplantis’ April letter to JDM Covenant Partners. Partners are those who support the ministry’s vision of world evangelism with donations and/or product orders, and they receive a letter each month from Brother Jesse sharing what God has put on his heart. We hope you enjoy reading a portion of this month’s letter and will consider becoming a Partner in JDM’s vision of world evangelism.*

Dear Partner,

The smell of spring is all over the city of New Orleans. New leaves, new flowers, and new bees too. New life is blossoming everywhere I look. It makes me think of the newness of salvation. When I got saved, it was like spring broke forth in my spirit. I became what 2 Corinthians 5:17 says: *“Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.”*

This year’s theme is about faith—it’s about only saying what faith says, and using your “faith voice” to bring forth what God has put on your heart. Partner, your faith voice will always have some “spring” in it, so to speak. Faith breathes new life into old dreams. It stimulates seeds to grow in the spirit. Faith is a creative force given to us by God, and this year we are focused on making our words align with it.

Our 2026 theme is, **“Only Say What Faith Says. Only Use Your Faith Voice.”** It’s based on Romans 4:17, which says, *“...even God, Who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were.”* You see, when we speak in faith, we’re speaking like God—we’re imitating Him as dear children, and we’re also following in the footsteps of Abraham, who is called the father of faith. The words of your mouth have power. What begins in the spirit doesn’t end in the spirit—it affects the natural.

I was reading Psalms the other day and chapter 35, verse 27 really spoke to my spirit. It says, *“Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of His servant.”* David wrote this under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, and he was using

his faith voice so that his enemies could hear it. In that verse are both the fruit of the spirit of joy and the emotional feeling of happiness.

Point one in this letter today is this: **Great thoughts and utterances should never be hard to receive.** It’s wonderful to shout for joy and be glad about serving God. We should be joyful that we’re on the side of His righteous cause, and that we have a Father Who gets great pleasure when we do well. God loves us and His intentions towards us are good. If you have a shout of joy inside of you that wants to come out, let it out! It’ll destroy all the heaviness in the room, and it’ll also magnify God to the other people who hear it.

Joy and gladness are a message. There is a whole sermon contained in a joyful shout and a glad heart. I can’t tell you how many times I’ve used my spirit of gladness and a shout of joy to shake up an intensive care unit in a hospital. I’ve seen hope light up in people’s eyes and ears. The utterance of joy isn’t hard for people to receive. In fact, they want it. You could call joy “intensive care” for the human heart. It is like medicine for the soul, and God wants us to realize that we’re supposed to be dosing it out to others.

Your faith voice is full of hope. Give it to people freely. Your faith voice is an interpreter of God’s Word and God’s ways. Let it out. Remember that you are an ambassador for the living God, and what you say should bring hope. That brings me to my second point: **Your voice of faith must have the honesty of conviction, the sincerity of purpose, and the earnestness of desire.** What I’m saying is that you are magnifying God when you speak with your faith voice with honesty, sincerity, and earnestness. Your convictions come through that faith voice. Your purpose and desires come through that faith voice too.

Even just a small shout of gladness that comes from your faith voice is powerful! One raw utterance of faith is worth more than a bunch of nice-sounding empty words, because faith holds power. So, when words, or even simple shouts of praise, line up with faith, things start springing up in the spirit.

Magnify God! Magnify the One Who has pleasure in your prosperity! Don't let anybody silence your faith voice with doubt and unbelief about the nature of God's wish that you prosper. Get yourself some scriptures and put yourself in them. Be honest, sincere, and earnest in your desire to have what you say. Put the Word in and speak it out. Let the faith inside of you lift you up. And if you feel a shout coming on, go ahead and let it out!

Only saying what faith says must be a constant in your life—it must be a habit to you. We are not called to doubt but to believe, and to encourage others to believe as well. That's what I mean about living with the honesty of conviction, the sincerity of purpose, and the earnestness of desire. That's what I mean by getting your faith in line with your words and making a conscious and constant choice to **“Only Say What Faith Says. Only Use Your Faith Voice.”** Get this down deep into your spirit and it will change everything in life for you.

I’m writing to you from Río Cuarto, Córdoba, Argentina. My husband and I are very happy to share that we have been Partners in the ministry for the past four months, and our finances have taken a turn for the better. We have paid off all our debts and our small business is growing. We also listen to your messages and really enjoy the time with you during the Boardroom Chats. Thank you for being God’s messengers. May God bless you immensely.

This praise report has been translated from Spanish into English for you to rejoice with us.

I just want to take a moment to thank you more fully for the beautiful email I received from you. I had already sent a brief reply, but the impact of your words deserves so much more than a quick email. Your message didn’t just arrive in the inbox—it arrived in the Spirit. It was a direct answer to prayer. I cried the entire time I read it. Thank you for standing in agreement with me, for taking the time to speak life over my situation, to declare the Name of our Lord over my life, and to remind me that God is faithful to His Word. Your words reminded me: I don’t need to faint. I don’t need to fear. The harvest is coming if I don’t give up. You reminded me that my Shepherd sees me, provides for me, and heals me, and that my mind, though under attack, is sound. You named my needs without ever hearing them spoken. I have also been in the middle of a fast—seeking the Lord for healing, direction, and restoration for both myself and my mother. Right when I felt weary, your letter arrived and gave me strength. It was like water to my soul. Thank you for covering me in prayer, for responding with love, and for speaking from the heart of God. I truly feel seen, heard, and covered by the anointing that rests upon your lives. May the Lord continue to bless and multiply all that you set your hands to. I am praying for your ministry in return, and trusting that double will be your portion for the seeds you sowed into my life through just one email.

Thank you, Lord, for all. I’m thrilled that I’m a Partner with JDM—souls saved, wisdom taught, and blessed every day I spend with you all.

Thanks so much, Pastor Jesse Duplantis, for an amazing teaching (What Faith Are You Living By?). It is always exciting to watch you because it is fun and educational at the same time.

I sent in my prayer request in May of last year for my mom, who was diagnosed with stage 4 cancer in her brain and lungs. She started her oral medication in early July and has been struggling with its side effects. In the meantime, I've continued to do what I know to do—feeding on your teachings, standing in faith, and praying for her. A couple of weeks ago, she went for an MRI and scans, and yesterday we received a very positive report from the doctor. Her brain is no longer swollen, the tumor in her brain has shrunk by 50%, and the tumor in her lungs has also shrunk by 30%. She no longer needs to take her medication daily, but only on alternate days. Praise the Lord for His healing! I will continue to stand on the Word and believe that this cancer will be completely gone—knocked down to stage 0. I'm currently in Japan on a three-month business trip. There are not many English-speaking churches around here, but I thank God that I can always tune in and watch your programs anytime. Thank you for always praying and standing in faith with me whenever I send in my prayer requests.

I have been so blessed by your obedience to preach the Gospel and teach people like me how to apply God's promises and principles in my everyday life. My year 2025 started with many financial challenges: from sending my son to college, figuring out how to pay for all his bills and student fees, and learning how to work through my marriage so we don't let finances tear us apart. It seemed like every day was a battle. I spent many hours listening to you and Cathy teaching the Word of God and applying God's promises to my life. My view and understanding of sowing and reaping for success in life was completely changed. I started speaking the Word of God. I started creating my own world and changing it. And sure enough, God's Word came through! It came to pass. It brought forth results above and beyond what I expected. In the beginning of the year, I cried a lot because of uncertainty, fear of failure, and embarrassment; but today I have tears of joy. I was able to pay my son's college tuition cash and debt-free, I was able to pay off my car, and today I'm able to pay off our cell phones. My marriage not only survived the financial pressures, but is doing better than before and growing stronger. My son was able to find a job and start sowing the way the Word of God teaches us to. All the bills are paid, credit cards are all paid off, and we did not go under. Thank you for your prayers and for being obedient to teach the Word of God to Christians like me who have struggled their whole life with debt and a poverty mindset. God is good and always faithful to His promises. I am closer to Him today than ever before, and His favor is upon my life and my family. I love you both very much, and I am so grateful for both of you and JDM!

Watching from the Philippines. Your funny but heartfelt messages were the starting point of my relationship with Jesus back in Singapore in 2015. I can now do things because Christ lives in me. Thank you, Lord...thank you, Jesse and Cathy. I'm now happy knowing the Lord daily. Through trials and tribulations, I can handle everything with confidence because Jesus is with me.

I sent in a prayer request asking God for a new house. Two weeks later, we got a beautiful new home with everything I need, just five minutes from my family, and even received extra money for the move. Praise God! Thank you for standing in agreement with me and my family.

Thank you, Sister Cathy, for teaching us about all the benefits that Jesus died for and rose again to give us! I bind the devil in every area of my and my family's life today. He has no place or right in our lives. I receive all the benefits that are recorded in the Bible for me and my family. Thank you for all that you and Brother Jesse do to spread the Gospel around the world! God's blessings to you and your ministry.

Jesse, I've been watching you for over twenty years and still love every minute of every sermon. Thank you. May God bless you and us with another twenty!

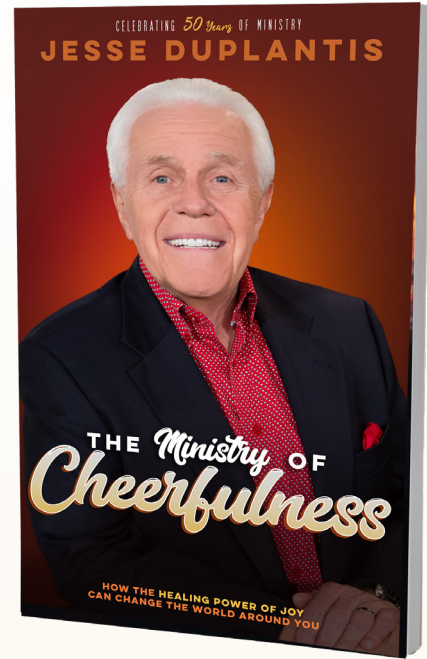

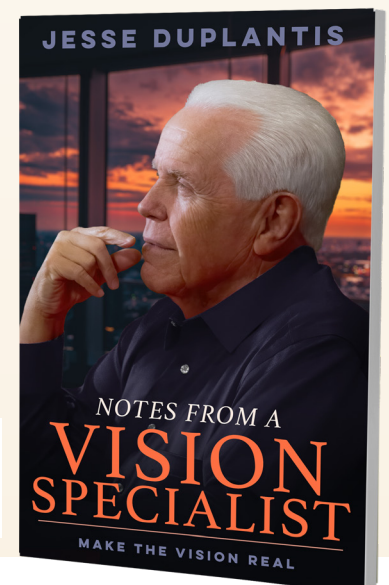

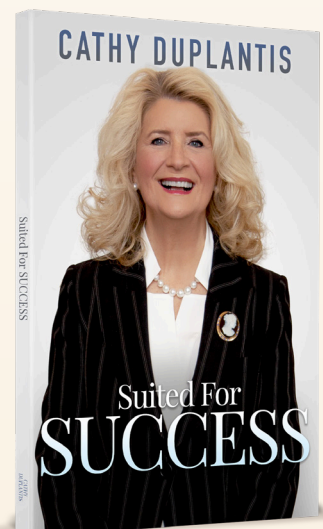

Faith Is NEVER Ordinary—It Is *Always* AMAZING!

Just a few of the synonyms for *ordinary* that I found listed in the dictionary are: average, common, usual, standard, unexceptional, and unremarkable. When you consider any one of these words, it is clear that there was nothing ordinary about the women that came to Jesus' tomb to anoint His body on that Sunday morning after He was crucified.

Their faithfulness to serve and care for Jesus, even after His death, was greatly rewarded. They were given the high honor of being the first to proclaim the message that Jesus is alive. However, when these women told the disciples the news that had so dramatically impacted their lives, it did not have the reaction they must have expected. The disciples did not believe it.

"So they rushed back from the tomb to tell His eleven disciples—and everyone else—what had happened. It was Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Mary the mother of James, and several other women who told the apostles what had happened. But the story sounded like nonsense to the men, so they didn't believe it" (Luke 24:9-11 NLT).

I don't know about you, but I expected the disciples that followed Jesus so closely to be more receptive to the awesome message of His resurrection. It seems that they had a wrong attitude toward the women that God had used to proclaim His message. They missed their opportunity to be amazing and fell into the trap of being ordinary.

Later that same day, two men were talking about everything that had happened as they walked along the road to Emmaus, a village seven miles from Jerusalem. As they continued to talk, Jesus walked up to them and asked them what they had been discussing so intently. Not recognizing Jesus and thinking that He was a stranger, they began to explain how the chief priests and rulers had condemned Jesus of Nazareth to death and crucified Him.

You can almost hear the despair in their words as they told the stranger how they had hoped that Jesus would redeem Israel. They told Him that some women came to them with an amazing report that Jesus had risen from the dead, but the words of the women were nonsense to the men. They would not believe, and therefore the message had no impact on their lives. They were still depressed and confused. To them, all hope was lost.

Luke 24:22-24 (NLT) says they told Jesus, *"Then some women from our group of His followers were at His*

tomb early this morning, and they came back with an amazing report. They said His body was missing, and they had seen angels who told them Jesus is alive! Some of our men ran out to see, and sure enough, His body was gone, just as the women had said."

Even though these two men were repeating the women's story to Jesus, they didn't actually believe it. We know that because of the strong rebuke and private sermon that Jesus gave to them, beginning in the very next verse.

"O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken: Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into His glory? And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, He expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning Himself" (Luke 24:25-27).

It is clear to me that ordinary people are slow of heart to believe, just like the two men that met Jesus on the road to Emmaus that day. They didn't understand that faith is never ordinary—it is always amazing! They are a stark contrast to the women that were at the tomb of Jesus early that morning to anoint His body with sweet spices. They had amazing faith and were quick to believe the angels' words: *"He is not here, but He has risen. Remember how He spoke to you while He was still in Galilee, saying that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again. And they remembered His words"* (Luke 24:68 NASB1995).

Those women spent a lot of time in Jesus' presence and heard Jesus warn all of His disciples about what would happen to Him. They did not dismiss the instruction of God's messenger—they were not slow of heart to believe and were given a message so powerful that we are still talking about it today. They remembered His message, they received the message, and they related the message to everyone. When the disciples first heard the message about His resurrection, they did not remember or receive it, and therefore could not relate it to others in faith.

God had entrusted faithful women with a message so dynamic and supernatural that it amazed those that heard it. Those women were not like other ordinary people that lived their lives to please people. They amazed the disciples because they were committed to pleasing God with their faith in His Word. They were filled with a divine boldness to relate the message that He is alive.

The messengers have changed, but the message about the resurrection of Jesus must still be remembered, received, and related until everyone has heard it. Christ has conquered death and paid the price for our sin with His precious blood on Calvary's Cross. God's great plan of redemption is available to all that call upon the name of Jesus.

Amazing Word

Jesse likes to tell people, “Give Cathy a butter knife and she can fix anything!” I think I inherited my talent for fixing things from my mom. My brother and four sisters and I watched her tackle anything and everything, from repairing the appliances to recovering old dinette chairs with tangerine Naugahyde (a cool style of vinyl upholstery made popular in the 1960s). Mom may not have known exactly what to do when she began, but she didn't let that stop her. Her determination led the way and got the job done.

As you may be able to tell, I am very proud of my amazing mom. Not just because she is an awesome cook and can fix stuff—but because she drips with love and showers kindness on everyone. Even when she was diagnosed with breast cancer in 2005, she seemed more concerned about her family than herself.

My first reaction to this news was to collect all the many healing scriptures that I had discovered over the years for my amazing mom. While compiling healing scriptures on my computer, I remembered that her sweet phone calls to me usually began with, “I just wanted to hear your voice!” So, I decided to record them on CD for her to hear while she read them on paper. I was determined to help my mom get saturated with God's promises concerning her healing.

My mom amazed us with her courage and determination throughout this ordeal, which included surgery to remove the breast with the cancerous tumor. She is still totally cancer free today. Glory to God!

The same scriptures I gave to my mom were later published in my book *The Healing Word*, which has been greatly used by God to share the message of His healing power to people all over the world. Although it began as a tool to help my mom, it has helped many others to realize that healing is always God's will.

Psalm 107:20 says, “*He sent His Word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.*” Long before any destructive attack was launched, God sent His amazing Word to deliver you. Instead of giving up when you hear a bad report, turn to God and believe His Word. Always remember that faith is never ordinary—it is always amazing!

Amazing Belief

Ordinary is not one of the words that would describe Mary, the young girl who was called by God to be the mother of Jesus. She could have shouted, “NO WAY,” when the angel told her how she would give birth to God's Son. Instead, she unleashed faith-filled words that propelled her toward that vision by declaring, “*...be it unto me according to thy word...*” (Luke 1:38).

Mary was an amazing young woman, and her cousin Elisabeth knew it the moment she heard Mary's voice. Immediately, the Holy Spirit filled the baby inside her womb, and Elisabeth declared this powerful truth to her young cousin: “*You are blessed because you believed that the Lord would do what He said*” (Luke 1:45 NLT).

Elisabeth was also far from ordinary. She and her husband, Zacharias, had never had children, and although she thought she was too old to conceive a child, God called her to give birth to John the Baptist. The angel's word to Mary about Elisabeth being with child in her old age is so powerful: “*For with God nothing shall be impossible*” (Luke 1:37).

Like Mary, each of us has a God-designed plan for our lives. Once His plan is revealed to us, we can follow her godly example. Instead of being ordinary, coasting along in life with no direction or following our own way, we can embrace God's plan. When we do, we will discover that faith is never ordinary—it is always amazing!

Amazing Life

You can live an amazing life that is victorious over any trouble that this world can unleash. The Bible is filled with examples of those who overcame impossible situations and glorified God with their lives. Heroes of faith like Abraham, Sarah, Joseph, Moses, David, Samuel, Elijah, and Elisha were anything but ordinary—they were amazing!

The same power of God that enabled them to do the impossible is available to you today. Ephesians (3:20) AMPC says, *“Now to Him Who, by (in consequence of) the [action of His] power that is at work within us, is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly, far over and above all that we [dare] ask or think [infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams].”*

This powerful verse is a divine challenge to continually move up to higher levels of believing. Don't settle for a life that is average, common, usual, standard, unexceptional, or unremarkable. God's purpose for your life is superabundantly, far over and above all that you can dare ask or think.

God can do infinitely beyond your highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams. He has given you amazing faith to believe His amazing Word to empower you to live an amazing life with Him.

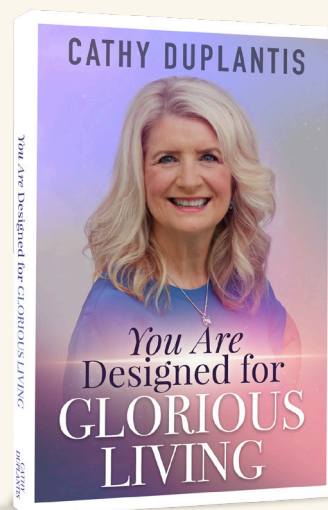
Are you fired up to get out of ordinary and be amazing? God is still seeking people who will believe Him and refuse to be ordinary. He needs more amazing people who will remember the message of Jesus, receive it by faith, and relate it with boldness to others.

Just as God gave Mary Magdalene, Joanna, and Mary the mother of James, words about Jesus'

resurrection from the dead that amazed the world, He has given you a message of hope to share with those around you. Let Jesus amaze you with His ability to calm the storms of life and speak peace to a troubled heart. You can stand on the promises in God's Word for your whole household to be saved. You can rebuke the enemy from blinding their eyes to the truth so that the light of the glorious Gospel can shine in their hearts (2 Corinthians 4:3-4).

It is time to go beyond the natural, ordinary ways of doing things and obediently move with Him in the supernatural and extraordinary. *“For the eyes of the LORD move to and fro throughout the earth that He may strongly support those whose heart is completely His...”* (2 Chronicles 16:9 NASB1995). God is looking for men and women that understand that faith is never ordinary—it is always amazing! 🌐

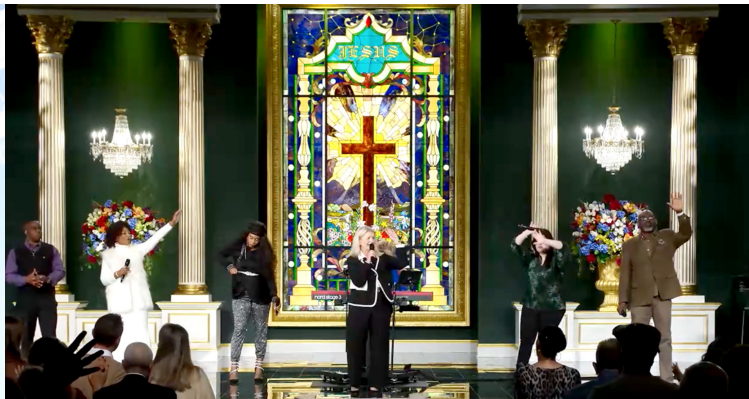

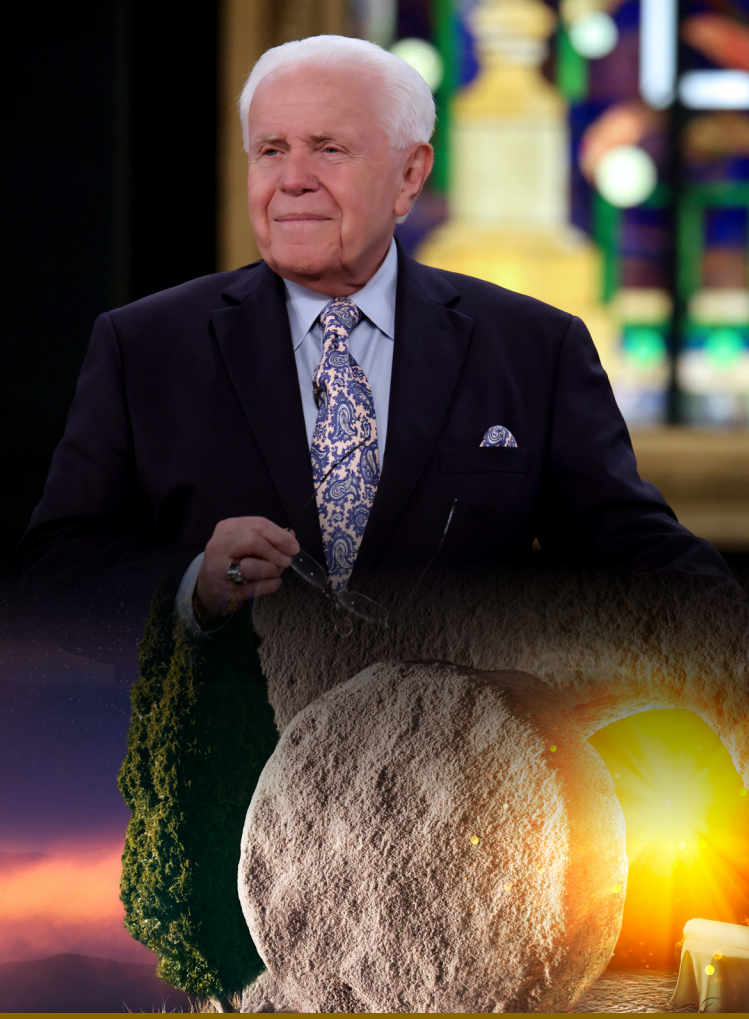
